

Achieving Behavioural Change



This one-day accredited Site Safety Plus course is designed to provide delegates with an understanding of how attitude and behaviour can affect the chances of accidents occurring.

The course is in line with the existing ACoP and Guidance for the Construction (Design and Management) Regulations 2007, which links to other legislation in requiring cooperation and co-ordination to be carried out.

As with the '4 Cs' from HSE's 'Working Well Together' Campaign, this course encourages participants to capture and apply the '9Cs' (Communication and consultation enables cooperation, co-ordination, collaboration, control and competence, establishing a culture and commitment at all levels).
