- Guidance on managing fire safety on high fire risk sites – such as high rise or large timber framed projects

16 Steps to Fire Safety on Timber Frame Structures

This guidance to good practice relates to timber frame sites under construction where materials will be exposed and where methods of working and security factors may increase the risk of fire.

Although it has been designed for timber frame sites, it is also relevant to other methods of construction.
